The BarbaraCares Foundation is a 501c3 nonprofit organization, (EIN: 83-3204570) Founded in 2018, BarbaraCares assist individuals battling breast cancer in Texas. We also support caregivers helping impacted persons while they are in active treatment. The organization has now expanded to service all 254 counties in the state of Texas. Our efforts consist of proactive methods involving advocating for expanded early mammography screenings, hosting educational seminars, providing community health fairs, and offering a variety of social supportive services for individuals recently diagnosed and currently in active treatment.



OBJECTIVES

- Focus on targeted proactive measures within identified zip codes to address rising latestage breast cancer diagnoses and mortality rates.
- Expand partner networks both locally and statewide to support growing organizational capacity.
- Bring on additional personnel to assist with strategic plan implementation.
- Obtain funding to support free expanded mammography screenings provided by BarbaraCares through December 31, 2021.
- Double supportive services including but not limited to financial grants, healthy meal vouchers, gas cards, counseling services, co-pay assistance, etc. provided through BarbaraCares for those in active treatment.


WHO WE SERVED
